

# RE: REQUEST FOR COMMENT ON THE BIGAI WETLAND MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT PLAN, KNYSNA MUNICIPAL DISTRICT

Your attention is drawn to the attached MMP for the Bigain Wetland in Knysna.

The Bigai Wetland runs through a portion of Knysna, bordering and including the Knysna Municipal Golf Club. It is a small catchment area. Historical and continued development along this catchment has resulted in (A) an increase in hardened surfaces which equates to an increase in stormwater runoff volumes and (B) there has been substantial erosion in this catchment area resulting in siltation and sediment blocking existing culverts and stormwater channels in the wetland. The system feeds into the Knysna Estuary and it is important that its function of providing freshwater to the Estuary is maintained (currently the blockages are compromising this function).



As a result, culverts and stormwater channels in the wetland are blocked (either by vegetation growth or sediment), resulting in chronic flooding which has increased over time. Some of the streets within this study area is permanently inundated with water resulting in tremendous challenges to residents and municipal workers alike who has to traverse these streets on a daily basis. **This MMP is ONLY for the clearing of culverts/existing stormwater channels in the wetland**. The majority of work will be done by hand with some areas requiring minimal machinery to excavate material.

The recommended maintenance work does **not involve the development of any new infrastructure or structures**. In summary, Table 9 of the draft MMP stipulates each of the areas (culverts) that must be cleaned out, along with their coordinates (these are also all mapped) and the necessary work methods and mitigation measures.

This document is in draft format and has been compiled by Confluent Consulting on behalf of the Knysna Municipality (as the landowner and Applicant). Confluent Consulting in turn requested that Cape EAPrac assist with the stakeholder engagement process prior to submission of the Final MMP to the National Department of Fisheries, Forestry & Environmental Affairs (DFFE) for decision-making.



RE: REQUEST FOR COMMENT FROM THE SUB-DIRECTORATE: COASTAL MANAGEMENT ON THE BIGAI WETLAND MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT PLAN (MMP) KNYSNA MUNICIPAL DISTRICT.

#### 1. LEGISLATIVE CONTEXT

- 1.1. The Integrated Coastal Management Act, 2008 (Act No. 24 of 2008) ("NEM: ICMA") is a Specific Environmental Management Act under the umbrella of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) ("NEMA"). The NEM: ICMA sets out to manage the nation's coastal resources, promote social equity and best economic use of coastal resources whilst protecting the natural environment. In terms of Section 38 of the NEM: ICMA, the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning ('the Department') is the provincial lead agency for coastal management in the Western Cape as well as the competent authority for the administration of the "Management of public launch sites in the coastal zone (GN No. 497, 27 June 2014) "Public Launch Site Regulations".
- 1.2. The Department, in pursuant of fulfilling its mandate, is implementing the Provincial Coastal Management Programme ("PCMP"). The PCMP is a five (5) year strategic document, and its purpose is to provide all departments and organisations with an integrated, coordinated and uniform approach to coastal management in the Province. The Department has developed the next generation PCMP that includes priority objectives for the next 5 years. This PCMP was endorsed by the MEC on 27 March 2023 and may be viewed at <a href="https://www.westerncape.gov.za/eadp/about-us/meet-chief-directorates/environmental-sustainability/biodiversity-and-coastal-management">https://www.westerncape.gov.za/eadp/about-us/meet-chief-directorates/environmental-sustainability/biodiversity-and-coastal-management</a>.

- 1.3. A key priority of the PCMP is the Estuary Management Programme, which is predominantly implemented through the Estuary Management Framework and Implementation Strategy ("EMFIS") project. The Department is implementing estuary management in accordance with the NEM: ICMA and the National Estuarine Management Protocol ("NEMP"). Relevant guidelines, Estuarine Management Plans, Mouth Management Plans need to be considered when any listed activities are triggered in the Estuarine Functional Zone. The Department is in the process of approving a series of Estuarine Management Plans. Both draft and approved plans may be viewed at DEA&DP: Coastal Management.
- 1.4. The facilitation of public access to the coast is an objective of the NEM: ICMA as well as a Priority in the WC PCMP. The Department developed the Provincial Coastal Access Strategy and Plan, 2017 ("PCASP") and commissioned coastal access audits per municipal district to assist municipalities with identifying existing, historic, and desired public coastal access. These coastal access audits also identify hotspots or areas of conflict to assist the municipalities with facilitating public access in terms of Section 18 of the NEM: ICMA. The PCASP as well as the coastal access audits are available on the Departmental website at DEA&DP: Coastal Management.

#### 2. COMMENT

- 2.1 The sub-directorate: Coastal Management ("SD: CM") has reviewed the information as specified above and have the following commentary:
- 2.1.1 The applicant is proposing a Maintenance Management Plan for the Bigai River Floodplain in the Knysna Municipality to clear culverts/existing stormwater channels in the wetland. The majority of the work is proposed to be conducted by hand with some areas requiring minimal machinery to excavate material. Furthermore, the recommended maintenance will not involve the development of any new structures or infrastructure.
- 2.1.2 The SD: CM notes that the Bigai River system feeds into the Knysna Estuary which provides an important function of providing freshwater to the estuary but currently this function is being compromised by the blockages.
- 2.1.3 The applicant has adequately considered the estuarine functional zone ("EFZ") and its purpose as some parts of the proposed maintenance sites are along the Knysna Estuary. The SD: CM also notes that the applicant considered the DEA&DP 2013 Lidar survey data of coastal areas.
- 2.1.4 The MMP adequately considered critical biodiversity and ecological support areas in accordance with the Western Cape Biodiversity Spatial Plan (2017).
- 2.1.5 The proposed mitigation measures as stipulated in the draft MMP are appropriate and practical and should be strictly adhered to, and as such the SD: CM does not object the Maintenance Management Plan for the Bigai River Floodplain.

- 3. The applicant must be reminded of their general duty of care and the remediation of environmental damage, in terms of Section 28(1) of NEMA, which, specifically states that: "...Every person who causes, has caused or may cause significant pollution or degradation of the environment must take reasonable measures to prevent such pollution or degradation from occurring, continuing or recurring, or, in so far as such harm to the environment is authorised by law or cannot reasonably be avoided or stopped, to minimise and rectify such pollution or degradation of the environment..." together with Section 58 of the NEM: ICMA which refers to one's duty to avoid causing adverse effects on the coastal environment.
- 4. The SD: CM reserves the right to revise its comments and request further information from you based on any information that may be received.


