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SITE VERIFICATION REPORT FOR PORTIONS OF REMAINDER ZANDHOOGTE 139 TERGNIET, MOSSEL BAY DISTRICT

The study site is situated within the urban edge of Tergniet, Mossel Bay District. The property area is approximately 10.2ha and zoned Agriculture.

The preferred development proposal covers the majority of the site, exclusive of servitudes.

The land use is vacant, however due to historic agricultural practice that involved mowing and grazing, the site is transformed.

The following themes have been identified in the Screening Tool:

Biodiversity (High)	The site is transformed with low ecological
	value due to the homogenous habitat.
Heritage/Archaeology (Medium)	The site contains no heritage features.
Botanical (Low)	Species diversity is low. Sensitive features
	include milkwood and cheesewood trees
	identified within the existing servitudes and
	Impala Road Reserve.
Aquatic (Low)	The site does not contain any watercourses
	or wetlands within 500m from the boundary
	of the site.
Civil (Low)	The site is within 15km from the closest
	airport, but poses not threat to civil aviation
	operations.
Defence (Low)	The site poses no threat to national defence.

Outcome of the basic assessment process will determine the need for any further detailed impact assessment.
