Cape Environmental Assessment Practitioners (Pty) Ltd. (Cape EAPrac) has been appointed by the applicants (Euphorbia PV (Pty) Ltd, Hillardia PV (Pty) Ltd and Verbena PV (Pty) Ltd), as independent environmental assessment practitioner (EAP), to facilitate the Scoping & Environmental Impact Reporting (S&EIR) processes required in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, Act 107 of 1998) and 2014 EIA Regulations for the proposed Euphorbia PV, Hillardia PV, Verbena PV and associated infrastructure on the abovementioned properties.

The Applicants, Euphorbia PV (Pty) Ltd, Hillardia PV (Pty) Ltd and Verbena PV (Pty) Ltd are proposing the construction of 3 x photovoltaic (PV) solar energy facility (known as the Euphorbia PV, Hillardia PV and Verbena PV facilities) located on a site approximately 10 km north west of the town of Lichtenburg in the North West Province. Each of the PV facilities will comprise several arrays of PV panels and associated infrastructure and will have a contracted capacity of up to 100 MW. The development area is situated within the Ditsobotla Local Municipality within the Ngaka Modiri Molema District Municipality and is accessible via the R505, located east of the development area.

The development area for the PV facilities and associated infrastructure will be located on the following properties:

- Portion 2 of the Farm Houthaalboomen 31;
- Portion 3 of the Farm Houthaalboomen 31; and
- Portion 4 of the Farm Houthaalboomen 31.

The infrastructure associated with each of the three 100 MW facility includes:

- PV modules and mounting structures;
- Inverters and transformers:
- Battery Energy Storage System (BESS);
- Site and internal access roads (up to 8m wide);
- Auxiliary buildings (22kV or 33kV switch room, gate-house and security, control centre, office, warehouse, canteen & visitors centre, staff lockers etc.);
- Temporary and permanent laydown area;
- Cabling between the panels, to be laid underground where practical; and
- Grid connection infrastructure, including:
  - Underground medium-voltage cabling between the project components and the facility substation; and
  - o Up to 132kV facility substation

The Houthaalboomen North collector substation/ switching station will facilitate the connection of the cluster facility substations to the Watershed Main Transmission Substation (MTS) via a single or double circuit 132 kV overhead powerline. The connection infrastructure associated with this grid solution (i.e. between the collector switching station and the MTS) will be assessed as part of a separate Environmental Application.

The procedures for Scoping & Environmental Impact Reporting processes in terms of the 2014 Regulations (as amended) are being followed for this project. The following activities listed in terms of these regulations are applicable:

- Basic Assessment The proposal includes MV cabling of up to 33
Kilovolts and facility substations with a capacity of up to 132 kilovolts.
The proposed main access road to the PV facilities will be up to 8m wide, but with the inclusion of side drains and gavel embankments, will exceed the threshold of this activity.
The proposed PV developments are considered to be commercial use and the total footprint size will exceed 1 hectare.
The existing access road from the R505 will be lengthened by more than 1km in order to reach the proposed PV developments.
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Description of project activity that triggers listed activity
The proposed PV facilities will each have a generation capacity of up to 100 megawatts.
The proposed PV facilities will each require the clearance of an area in excess of 20ha and as such exceeds the threshold of this activity.
