As per our telephonic discussion earlier regarding the permit application for discharge of Industrial effluent.

We use sea water and fresh water for processing of our fish.

All our waste water are passed through a filtration system with 1 mm screening.

The water are tested on a monthly basis for micro levels by a SANAS accredited laboratory and every three months for chemical analysis by a SANAS accredited laboratory. (see results)

The Waste material are all organic and are collected by a fish meal plant for further processing.

The water travel a distance of less than ten meters and are discharge back into the sea.

Warren Manuel was here at our site last week and I explained and showed him the whole process.

Please indicate if we should still apply for the permit?
