Mossel Bay Municipality hereby confirms the following:

Solid waste and disposal:	
(i) The total existing capacity of the municipal waste site;	The Regional Waste Management site next to Petro SA will be able to accommodate the proposed Development. The site will be ready to receive waste from December 2024. The first phase will provide landfill airspace to all participating municipalities for a period of 10 years.
(ii) Any additional capacity at the municipal waste site (i.e. expansions) already approved by the environmental authority, but not yet effected;	The Regional Waste Management site is currently under construction next to Petro SA.
(iii) Unallocated waste disposal capacity available to service both the phased and completed (total) expected solid waste output load by the abovementioned applications, or sufficient approved unallocated capacity able to accommodate the abovementioned applications in future.	The Regional Waste Management site next to Petro SA will be able to accommodate the proposed Development. The first phase of the new landfill will provide adequate landfill airspace to all the participating municipalities for 10 years.
